DESCRIPTION

This program celebrates musical diversity by embarking on a journey through Spain, France, Russia, and Germany, with compositions from various eras and cultures.

At its core, CreArtBox presents arrangements of piano masterpieces like the Petite Suite and Pictures at an Exhibition, originally written for piano but adapted here for chamber music.

These iconic pieces, rearranged by established composers for orchestra, have become staples of 20th-century repertoire.

In addition to these classics, the program features Rachmaninov's piano trio and Telemann's flute quartet, accompanied by a piece by CreArtBox's Resident Composer, Andrea CasarRubios.
