DESCRIPTION

Just as various paint colors can stand alone or blend with others, simultaneously concealing and revealing the underlying paper texture, so too do the distinct tonal colors of the flute, cello, and piano sound alone or in combination, with melody and rhythm shaping their basic textures.

Gaubert's "Trois Aquarelles" encapsulates the essence of French impressionist painting through sound, mirroring the visual allure of watercolor technique.

This program presents a selection of renowned works for this instrumentation, including trios by Mendelssohn and Weber, while also offering glimpses into the minimalist landscape through the captivating works of Max Richter, adding depth and diversity to the auditory palette.
